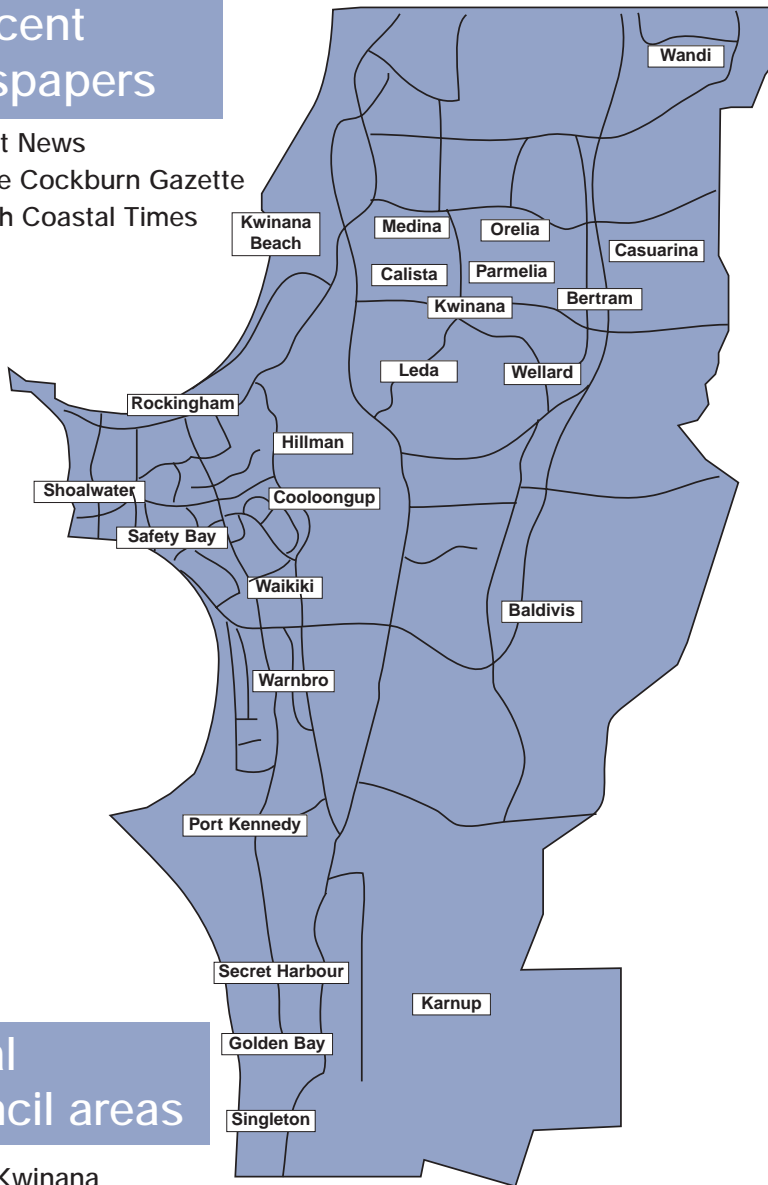

A vibrant, growing community

WEEKEND COURIER is distributed each Friday to homes and businesses in the City of Rockingham, one of the fastest growing regions in Australia.

The area is home to a mix of first home buyers attracted by affordable housing, longer-term residents in older, established suburbs and a significant UK born population. Families with dependent children and pre-retirement couples represent the majority of households. Separate houses remain the most common dwelling type with homes being purchased the dominant tenure type.

The manufacturing, retail and construction sectors are the main sources of employment and 74% of people who work in the City of Rockingham live locally.

The revitalisation of the Rockingham beachfront will provide significant commercial and tourism opportunities. Upgraded community facilities, new infrastructure, more diverse housing options and the southern rail line have increased the area's appeal. The population is expected to grow to 145,000 by 2021.

KWINANA COURIER is distributed each Friday to homes and businesses in the Town of Kwinana, a region with a relatively young population profile and undergoing unprecedented growth.

Families with dependent children and couples (young couples and baby-boomers) represent the majority of households. Occupation status favours skilled trades and semi-skilled /unskilled workers, many of whom are employed directly or indirectly by the Kwinana industrial precinct.

Separate houses account for 90% of dwellings with homes being purchased the dominant tenure type.

An estimated \$11.5 billion will be invested in residential, industrial and commercial developments over the next 15 years. Increased residential development offering affordable housing options coupled with significant growth in employment opportunities and improved retail and recreational facilities are creating a vibrant community.
